

AT A GLANCE



Dehradun the Capital of Uttarakhand is one of the most beautiful resort in the submountion tracts of India, known for its salubrious climate and scenic surroundings. Doon, aside often called, has been a favourite setting ground of the elite for nearly two centuries though its history streches back to many a millennia. The name Dehradun appears to be a collection of two words "dera" a camping ground. The Dronacharaya the common Guru of the Pandavas and Kaurava of the Mahabharat and the illustrious son of goddess Ganga, set up an ashram here, near the village of Dwara to perform his devotions at a lonely spot. The place came to be known as Dron Ashram, which eventually become Dun.

Earliest tangible evidence of the history of Dehradun is glimpsed from a rock inscription of Emperor. Ashok, 3rd century, BC, that was discovered in 1860 AD by a Britisher, Mr. Forrest, near Kalsi. The region then formed part of the Emperor's domain. After disappearing from history, perhaps, because it was deserted, it re-emerges in the territory of the Katyuri dynasty of Grahwal. In late 18th century it was conquered by the Gorkhas of Ran Bahadur of Nepal, who were replaced by the British in 1815 AD. Under the British, Dehradun became an elite town with many a fine institutions like Forest Research Institute, Doon and Welham School, ONGC and Wdia Institute of Himalayan Geology, were added in time. Dehradun has now become an important tourist destination, too for its surroundings offer an interest to the visitor.

Rail : Dehradun is an important railhead on the Northern Railway and is connected to all major cities in India.

Road: On state Highway Dehradun is well connected by motorable road to Mussoorie-35 kms, Delhi-235 kms, Haridwar-54 kms, Bombay-1927 kms, Rishikesh-42 kms, Agra-480 kms, Shimla-280 kms Yamnunotri-173 kms.

Location: Dehradun is situated in the north Indian state of Uttarakhand about 235 kms from Delhi. Dehradun extends from the latitude 30° 19' in the North to longitude 78° 04' in the East. The city of Dehradun is well connected to other cities of north India by rail, road and air. Surrounded on the east by river Ganga, on the west by Yamuna the Doon Valley is a most picturesque region at the foothills of the panoramic Shivalik ranges.

Climate: Due to its location in the hilly part of the state, the climate of Dehradun is salubrious. During the summer months, temperature ranges between 36° C and 16.7° C. The winter months are colder with the maximum and minimum temperatures touching 23.4° C and 5.2° C respectively.

Past : Dehradun is one of the oldest cities in India. In the Vedic times, the Garhwal Mandal, of which Dehradun is a part, was known as the kedar Khand. Legend has it that Guru Dronacharaya, a Brahmin teacher of warfare, considered Dehradun a place fit for meditation and workship and therefore, the valley of Doon as christened Dron Ashram, Which means "The Abode of Drona".

The written history of Dehradun dates back to 250 BC and King Ashoka's inscription at Kalsi, on the outskirts of the city, is proof of this. There are 14 edicts carved on a rock and nearby is the site of three horse sacrifices by Raja Shilvarma of the Vrisheri dynasty. Large bricks with writing on them are laid out in the shape of a huge bird with a fire alter in the middle.

Th sikh saint Guru Ram Rai also camped here at the place where the present Guru Ram Rai Darbar is located. Like most other Indian hill stations, the British found the climate and the serene environment of this place closer to their home and established many well-known institutions.





The Drona School is the most centrally located school in Sahaspur Dehradun.

Criterion for Admission

The parents are supposed to fill-in the admission form (given in the prospectus) and submit it in the office along with 2 passport size photos of the students and 1 Passport size photo of the student with his parents.

It is the disposal of the Principal to accept or deny admission to the student.

Admission will be subject to the availability of seats.

Preliminary Instruction for New Entrants

The Child will be allotted a date to start coming to the School.

For the first few days the child will attend the school only for half an hour. The parents are drop and collect the child accordingly. The timings will be extended slowly to enable the child to develop a positive interest for the school as well as studies.

Attach a duly filled Identity Card and a Hanky on the shirt or pullover of the child. The Identity Card can be collected from the Office.

The Child should carry a small bag with a tiffin box and a water bottle. His/her name should be written on all the three (bag, tiffin, water bottle.)

The child should be sent to the school proper school in uniform from the very first day.
